COMPOSITION IS KEY

A CLASS IN ABSTRACT WATERCOLOR PAINTING

This class is based on learning how the elements of art create a well-balanced and visually flowing painting. The students will learn about these elements, and how to use them effectively. They will be asked to make a free-flowing watercolor, with washes of color which will become a base for the placement of exotic art papers. These papers can be arranged in all directions on the base until a satisfactory composition is achieved. The next steps are to attach these papers to the base with gel medium, add paint in various areas for unification, and use linear additions for variety and a visual pathway through the painting. All these things are at the discretion of the artist, which is the focus of the class.
