

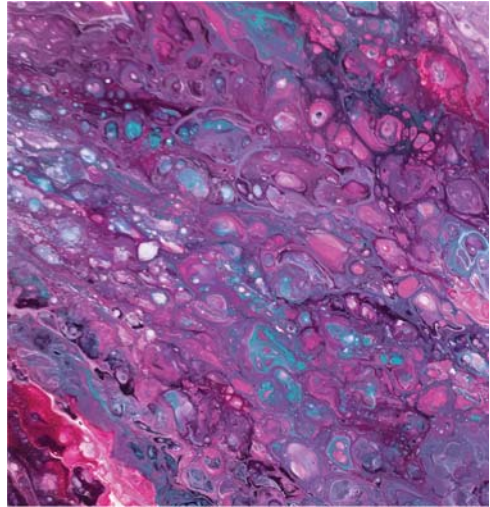

SUPPLY LIST

- Acrylic Fluid paints or Soft Body (Golden or Amsterdam)
I recommend the three primary colors and Titanium White.

- Surface Stretched canvas 5x7 or 6x6. Canvas panels or yupo are also fine. (Nothing bigger than 8x8 as space is limited)

Other items:

- Floetrol the one for acrylic and not oil. (at the hardware store)

- An Old towel or paper towels

- An Apron for your use

- If you have a small food torch. You can get inexpensive ones from Amazon (Not necessary)

- Large foil baking pan to put canvas in for the run off All other items will be provided.
